

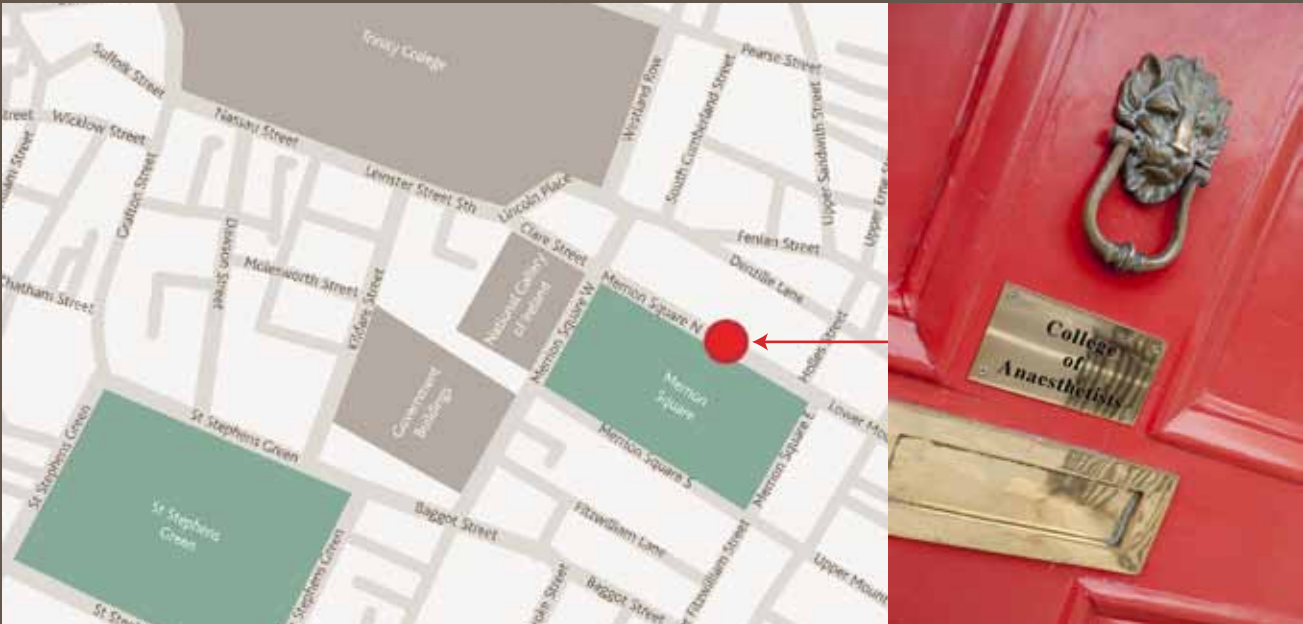


## TRAINING FACILITY

## OUR LOCATION

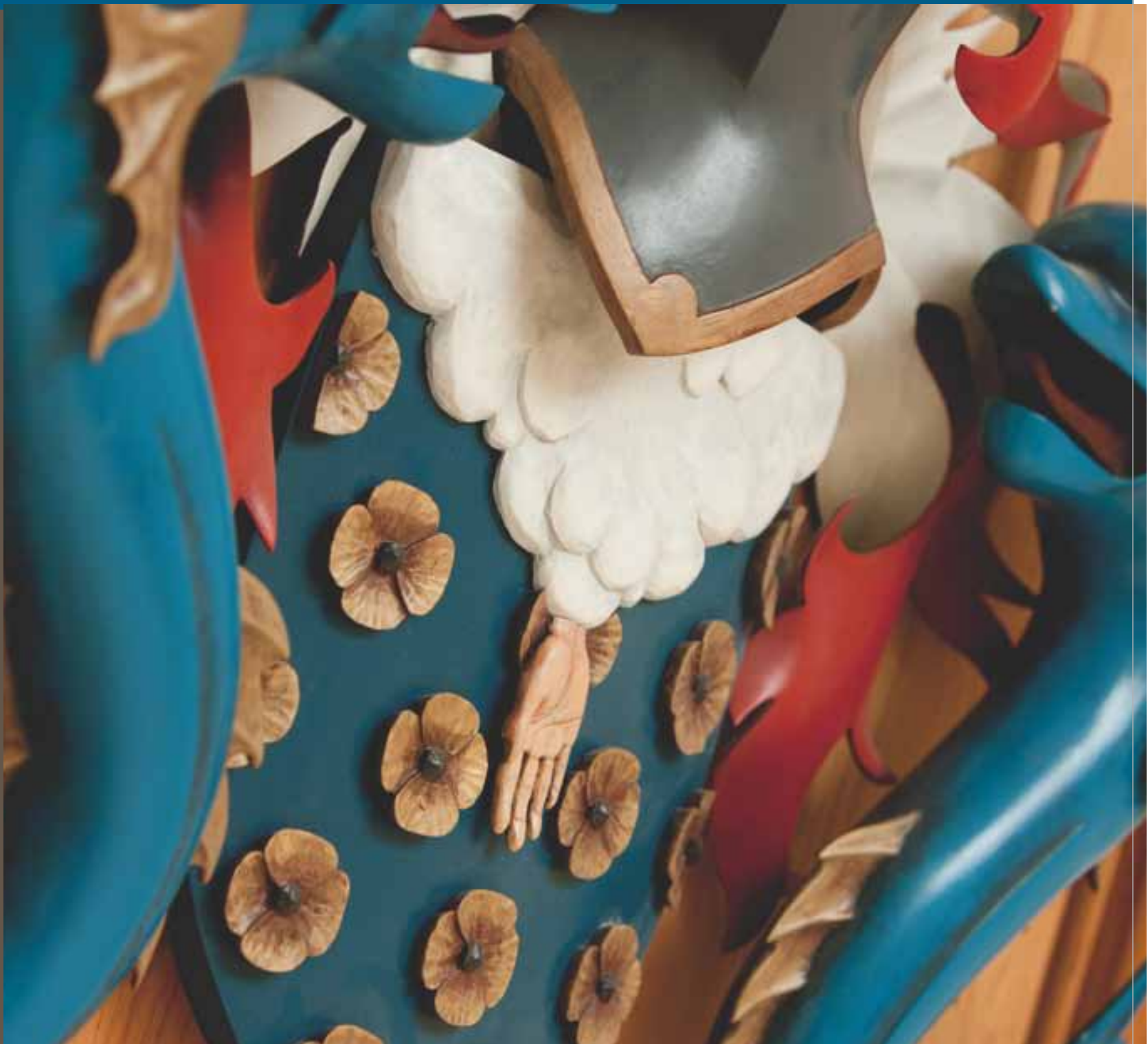
Merrion Square is one of Dublin's most prestigious addresses with many of the city's major hotels and visitor attractions on the doorstep.

Merrion Square was laid out in 1762. It is home to Leinster House, Government Buildings, The National History Museum and The National Gallery. It is also the birthplace of Oscar Wilde, and home at various times to WB Yeats, Daniel O'Connell and Sybil Connolly.

The original Faculty of Anaesthetists was founded in 1959 as a faculty of Royal College of Surgeons Ireland. It became a College in its own right in 1998 and in the same year acquired it's headquarters at 22 Merrion Square North.

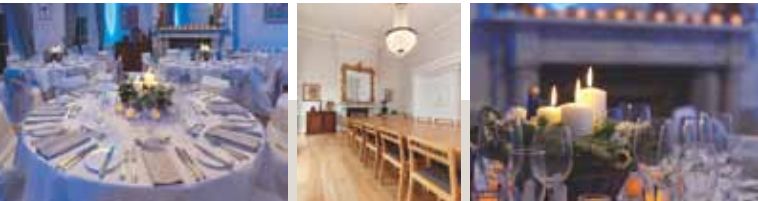
## GILMARTIN ROOM
